## National Numeracy Day

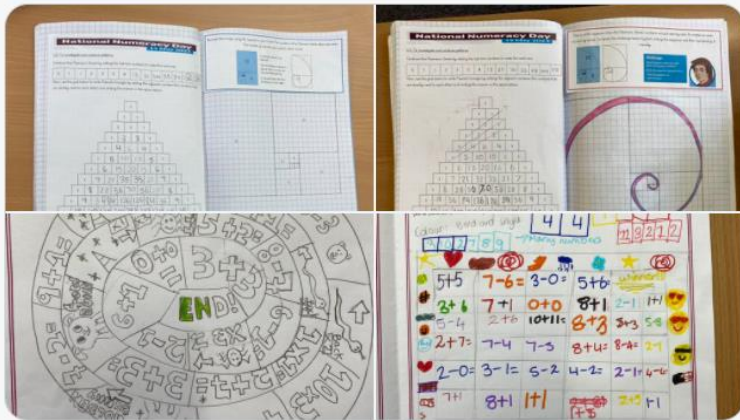
