RHSE Update

Following the consultations with parents in January 2020 and June 2021, we have revisited the Government RHSE documentation and at Springfield we will now be calling it the RHE policy as we are only teaching the Relationships and Health sections and not the 'S' element.

I have met with faith leaders and had discussions with local headteachers, including from faith schools to explore how they are delivering the RHE curriculum. Next week, I will be meeting with a consultant, who will be supporting us to further develop our RSE curriculum in a way that ensures all statutory requirements are met, children are receiving the education they deserve and it is community friendly.

Following this I will be asking for parents who would like to join myself, a faith leader and the consultant to discuss our proposed plans.
