Friday 16th December 2022 will be the last day of the Autumn Term.

We would like to inform parents that school will close to all pupils at 1.30pm.

As it is the last day, children will be taking part in festive activities and can come to school wearing their Christmas jumper/ non uniform.

### Strep A Guidance

As you may well have seen in the press there have been several Streptococcus -A infections reported across schools nationally.

We want to provide some information for actions you can encourage at home and at school to ensure your child's safety.

Good hand and respiratory hygiene are important for stopping the spread of bugs. By teaching children and role modelling how to wash their hands properly with soap for 20 seconds, using a tissue to catch coughs and sneezes, and keeping away from others when feeling unwell, they will be able to reduce the risk of picking up or spreading infections.

### **Prime Energy Drinks**

We would like to remind parents that 'Prime' energy drinks are not allowed in school.

Soft drinks, energy drinks, milkshakes etc are not allowed.

If pupils are found to have these drinks, they will be confiscated and returned to parents at the end of the day.

We ask parents to send pupils to school with bottles of water only.

Please remind your child that water bottles can be refilled throughout the day if needed.
