Parents can now apply online for your child to start Secondary School in September 2024 the deadline for applications is 31st October.

Please visit the above website to make an application for your child. If you need help completing the process, there will be members of staff to support you at the secondary school transfer meeting at school on 29th September.

Attendance and Punctuality

School gates open at 8:45am and close at 8:55am, after this your child will be considered late. The Stratford Rd gate is open from 8:30 for wake up shake up if you need to drop your child earlier for any reason. It is extremely important to arrive on time and avoid missing learning. If your child arrives after 9:30am they will receive a 'U' code which is an unauthorised absence for the morning. As a result, this will have a significant impact on attendance and could lead to further action being taken. If you are struggling to arrive on time and would like some support, please speak to Miss Stringer or Mrs Hussain. If your child is not well enough to attend school, please remember to follow the absence procedures and report this to the school office before 9am if possible.
